

## **SCHEDULE 6 TO BY-LAW NO. 1**

### **PROVISIONS RESPECTING REIMBURSEMENT FOR OFFICIAL VISITS TO LOCAL SOCIETIES**

1. Council members representing electoral districts are encouraged to make official visits to each local dental society within their respective electoral districts. At such meetings, council members should be provided with the opportunity of addressing the members on such issues relating to the mission of the College as are deemed by the council member to be appropriate. One visit per year should be considered a minimum but fee and expense coverage will be provided for up to two meetings, which may include either or both society general meetings and society executive committee meetings, as appropriate. No fees or expenses will be provided for the attendance of a council member at his/her home society's meetings, either general or executive, where the one-way travel distance is less than fifty kilometres from the member's principal residence. 2. Normal travel expenses will be provided consistent with the College's expense policy.
3. If it is necessary, in order to travel to a local society meeting, that an entire work day be lost in the process, then the currently applicable full-day fee will apply.
4. If it is necessary, in order to travel to a local society meeting, that a half work day is lost in the process or if no office time is lost but the meeting consumes the evening, then the half-day fee currently applicable will apply.
5. Any dispute relative to paragraph 3 or 4 above shall be decided by the finance, property and administration committee. (Amended 99.05)
